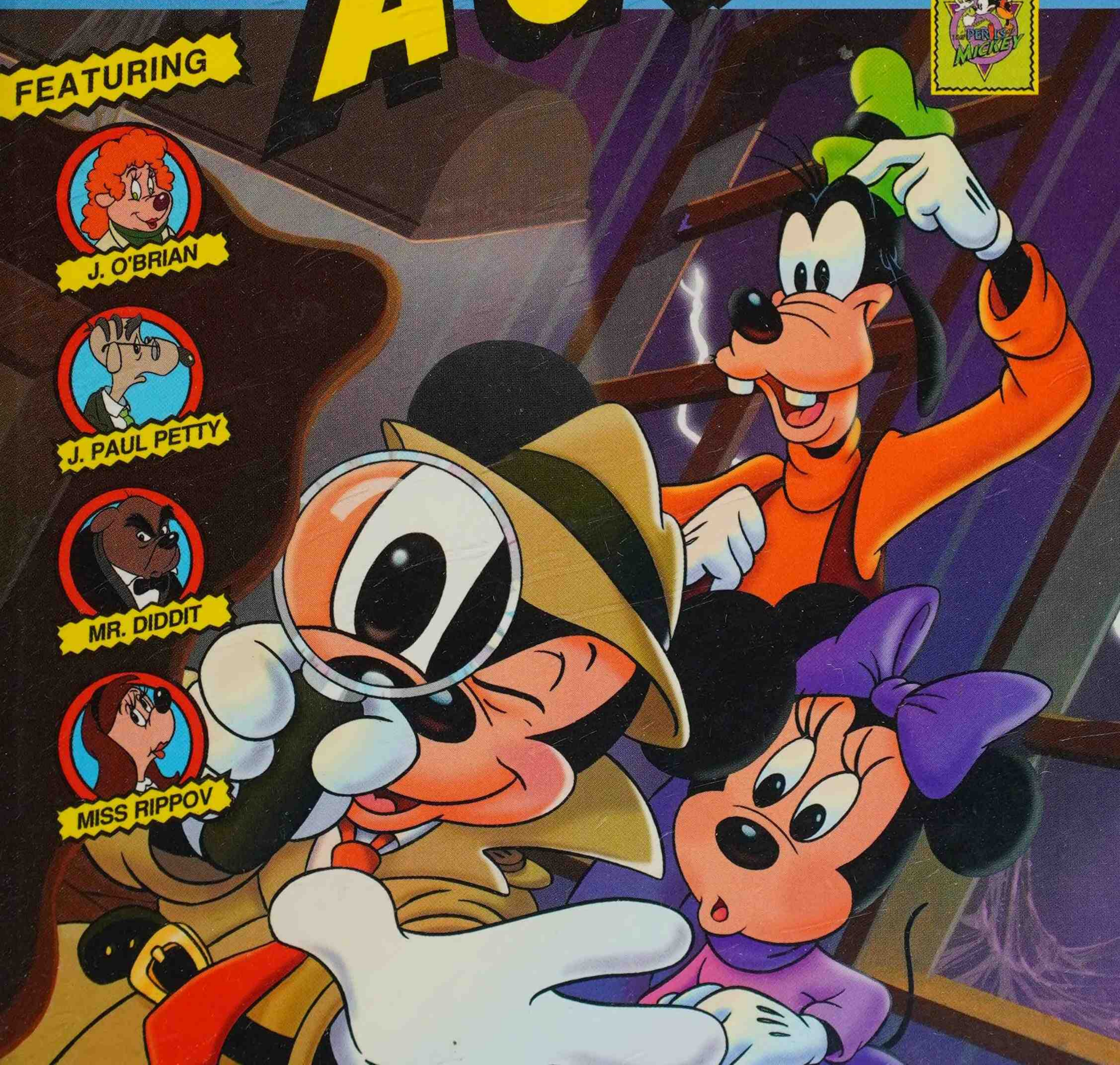

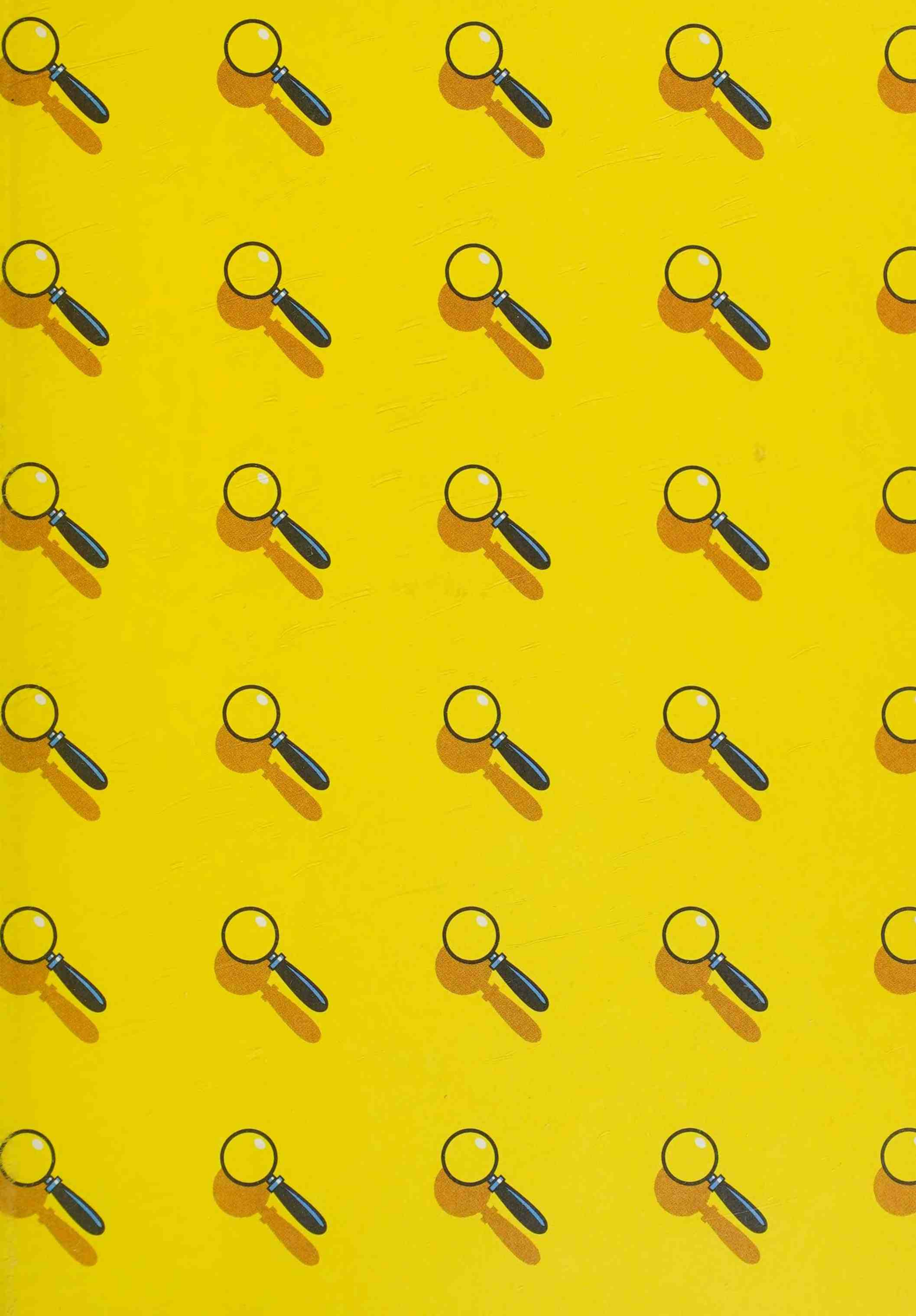

HOW TO USE THE MICKEY MYSTERY KIT

Help Mickey solve this Whodunnit Mystery. The audio cassette and the book are full of secret clues that point out important things to pay attention to in the story. There are *three ways* to find these clues:



Listen *very* carefully for clues in the story on the *audio cassette*.



Look for clues in each scene of the *picture book*.



Use your *secret decoder* to read hidden clues contained in the squiggly pink area in Mickey's magnifying lens or in any other place on the page that has the same pattern.

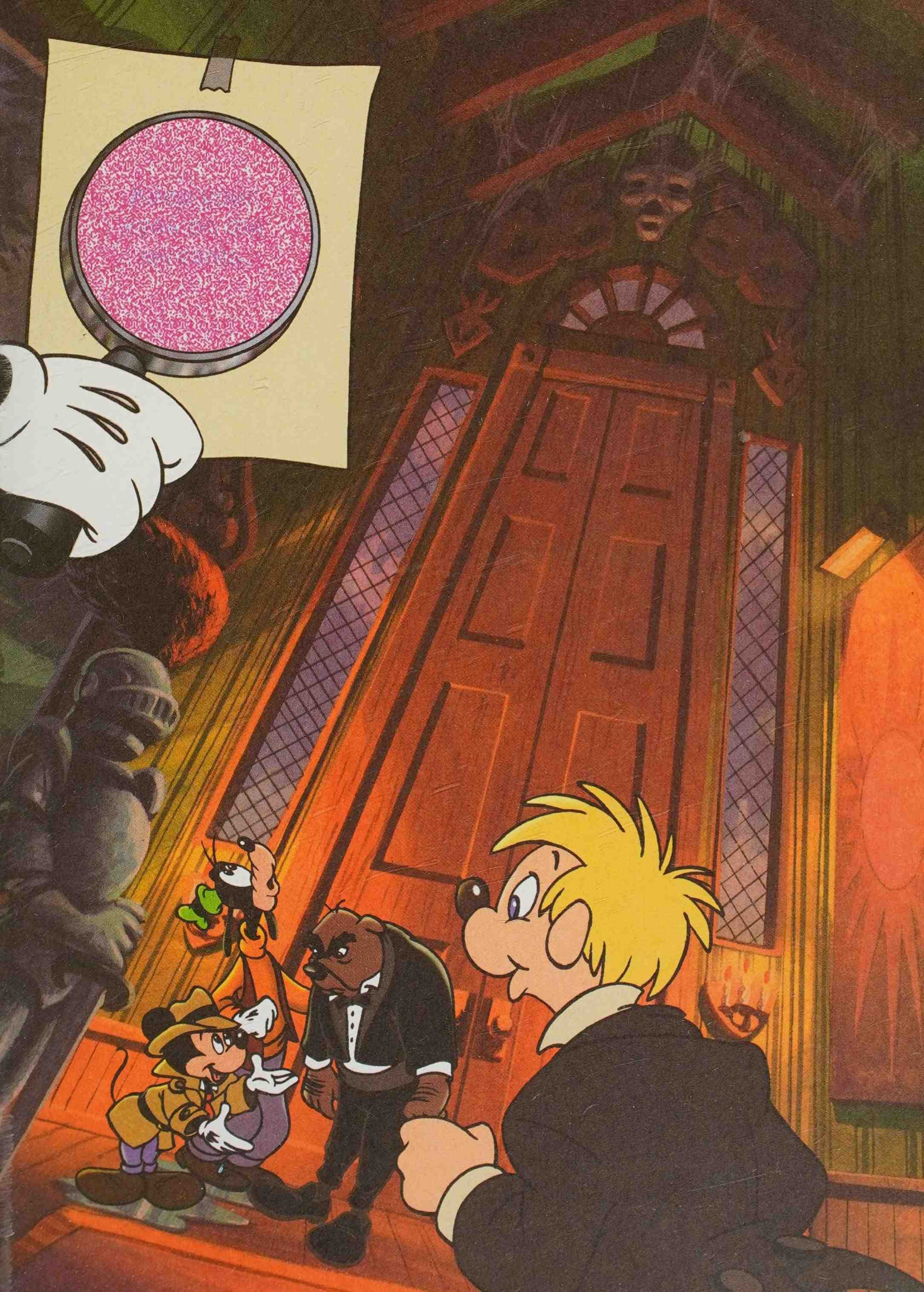
When listening to the audio cassette, you'll hear music at the end of each scene. This means you'll have 10 seconds to find all the clues on the page before you go on to the next scene. (You can stop the tape if you need more time).



Collect all the clues and review them at the end of the story. When you think you have the answer, use your secret decoder to read the last page of the book and turn over the audio cassette to hear Mickey's explanation of the crime.

Before we begin, let's try identifying a hidden clue together. Put your lens over the squiggly pink area. You should see this message: *CLUE*

Are you ready? Let's begin.



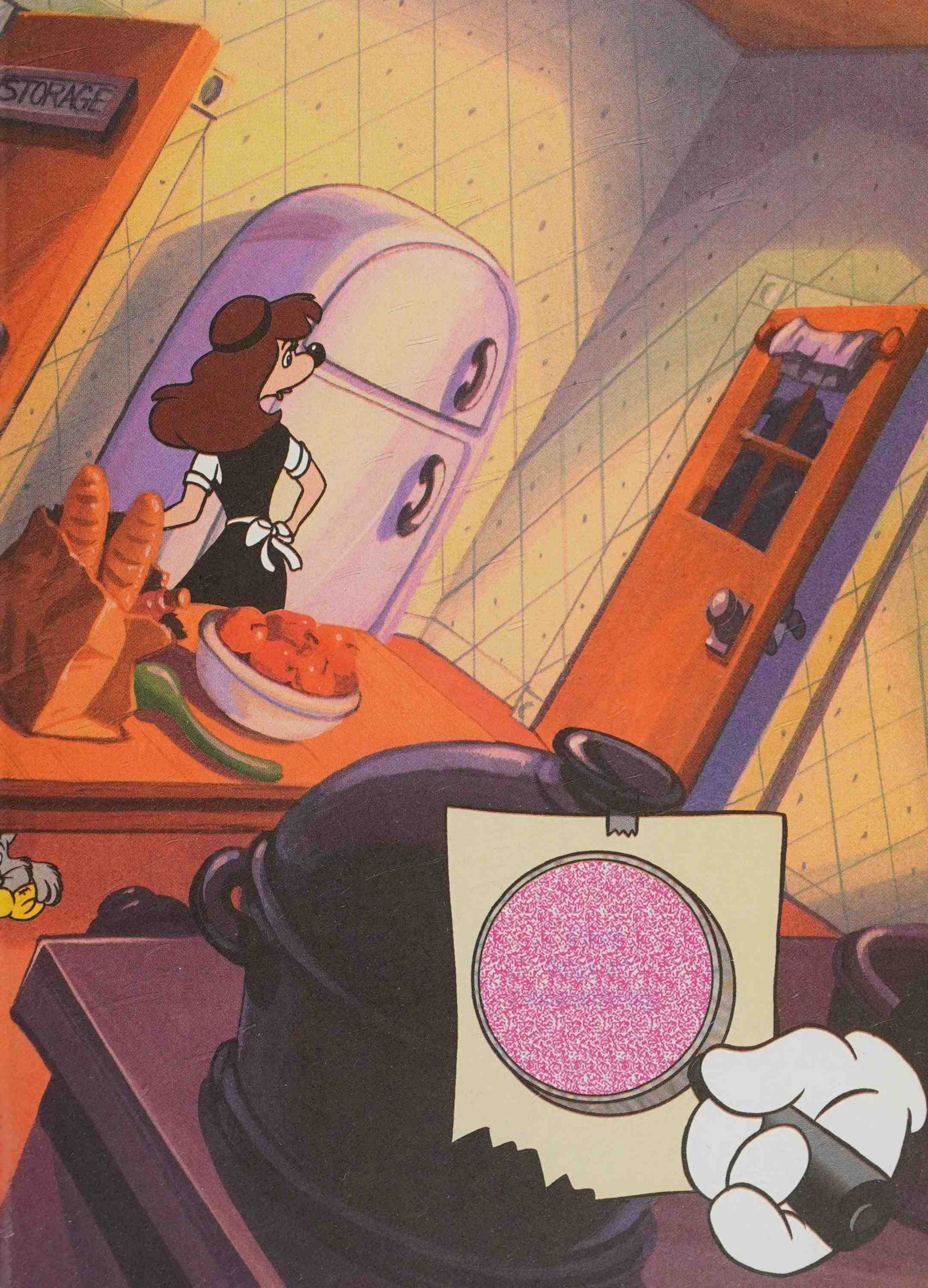






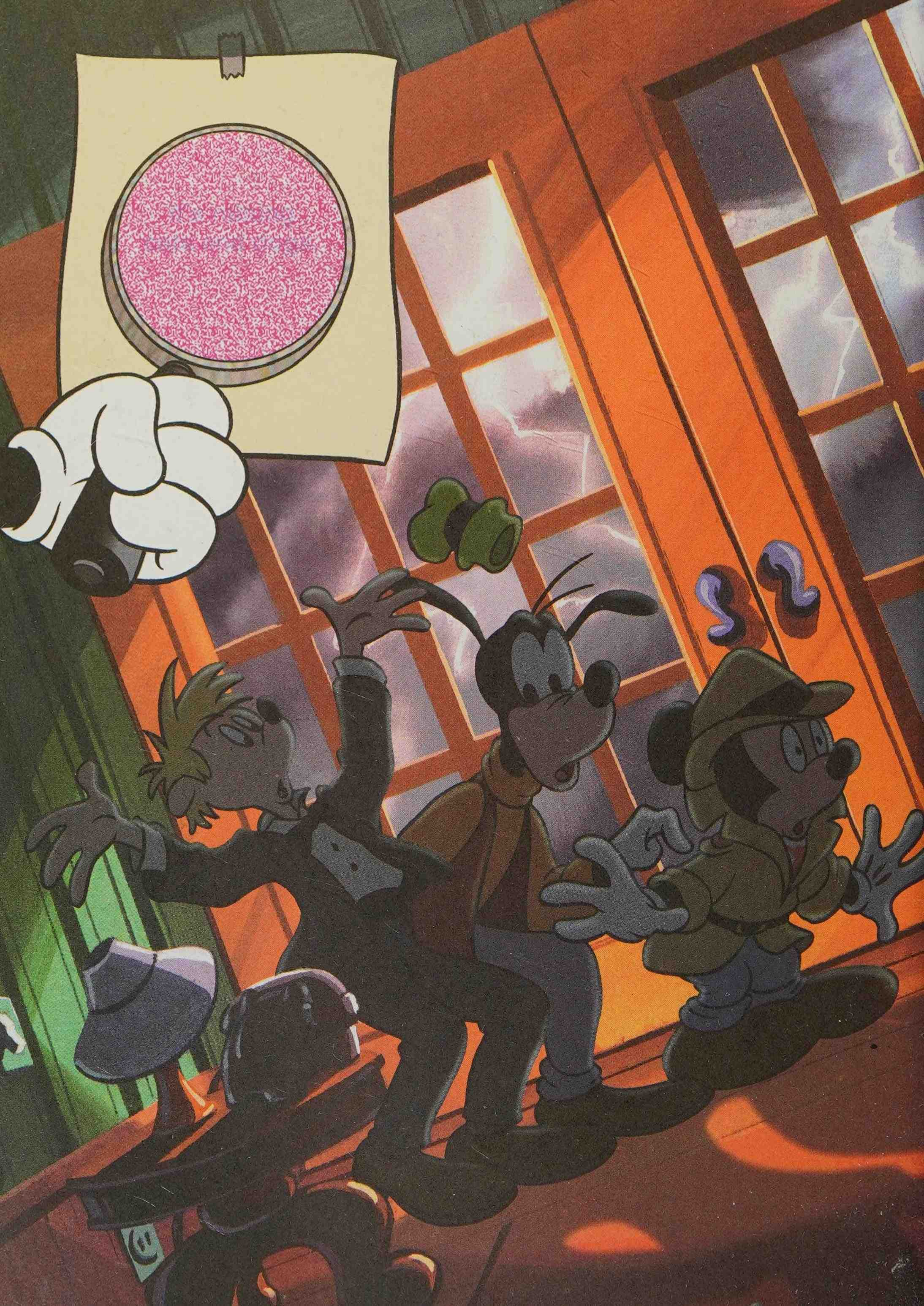






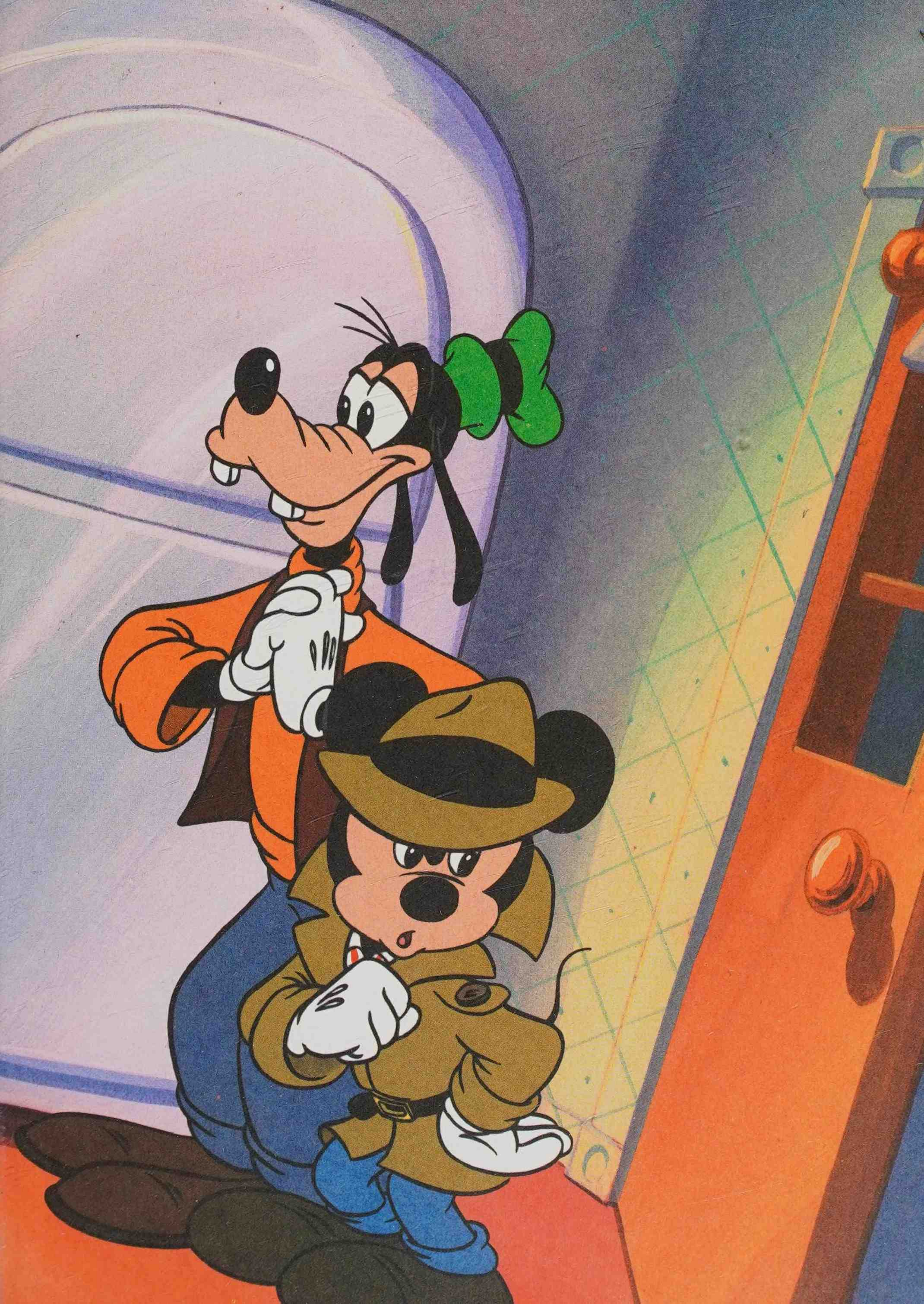


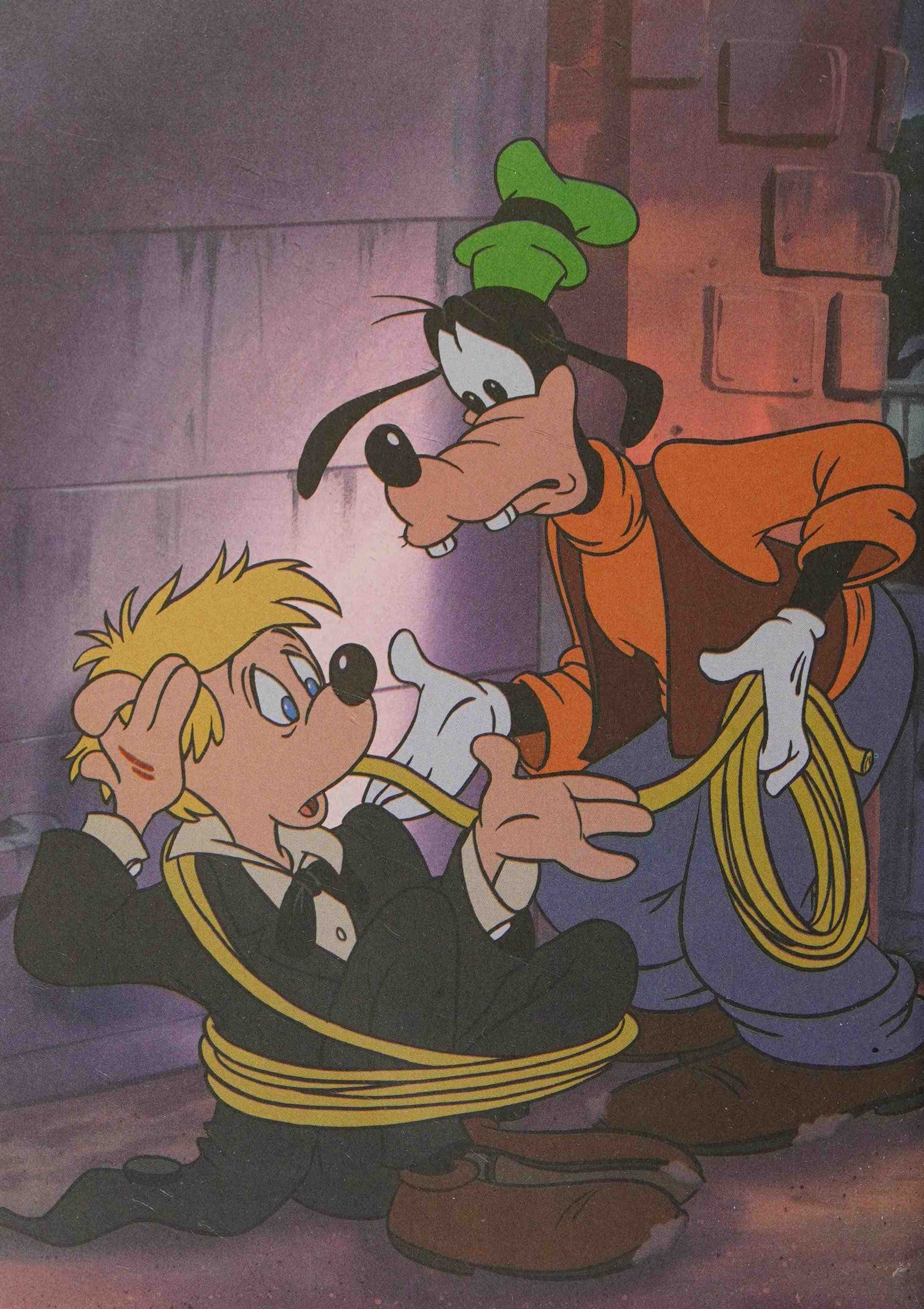


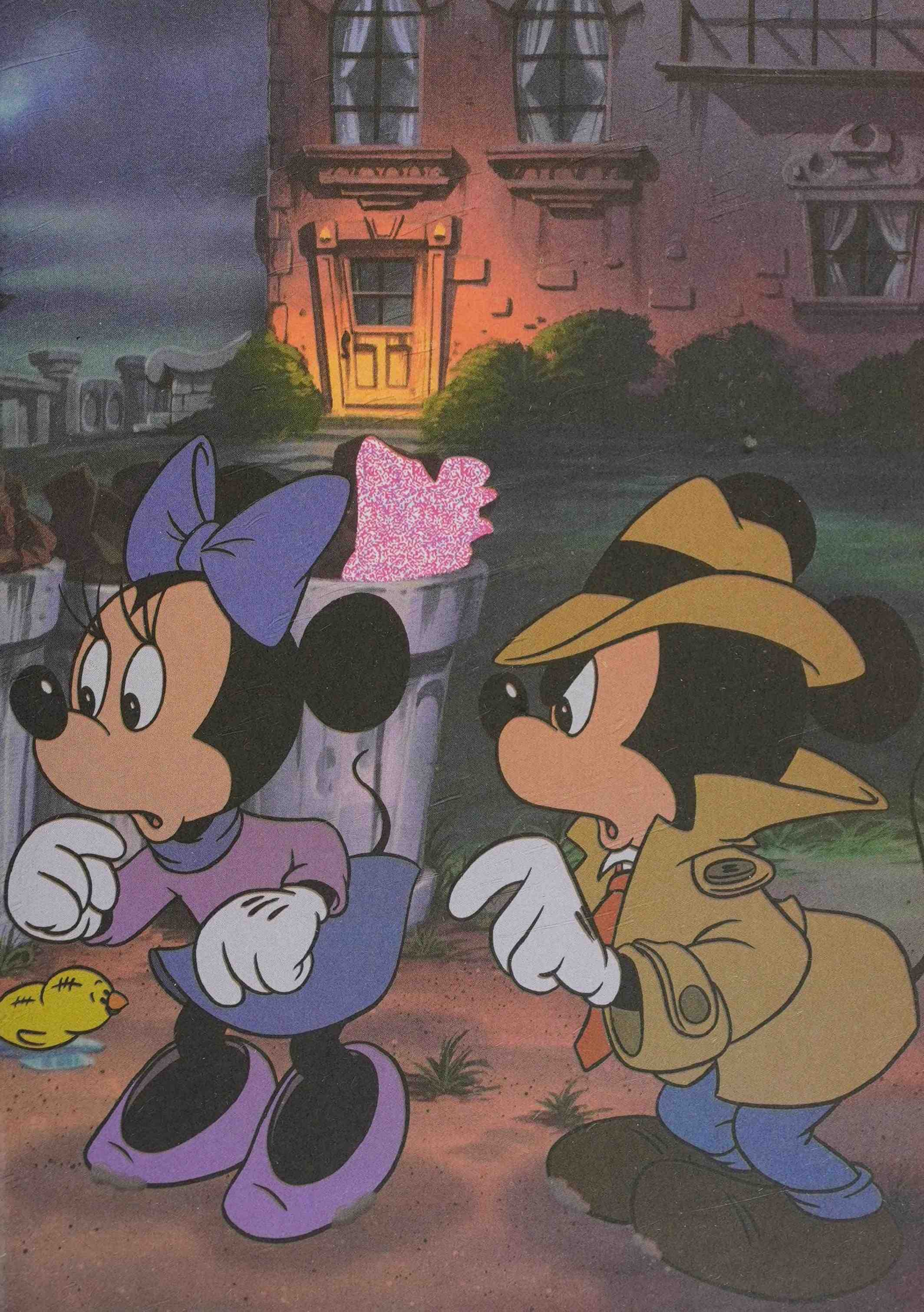




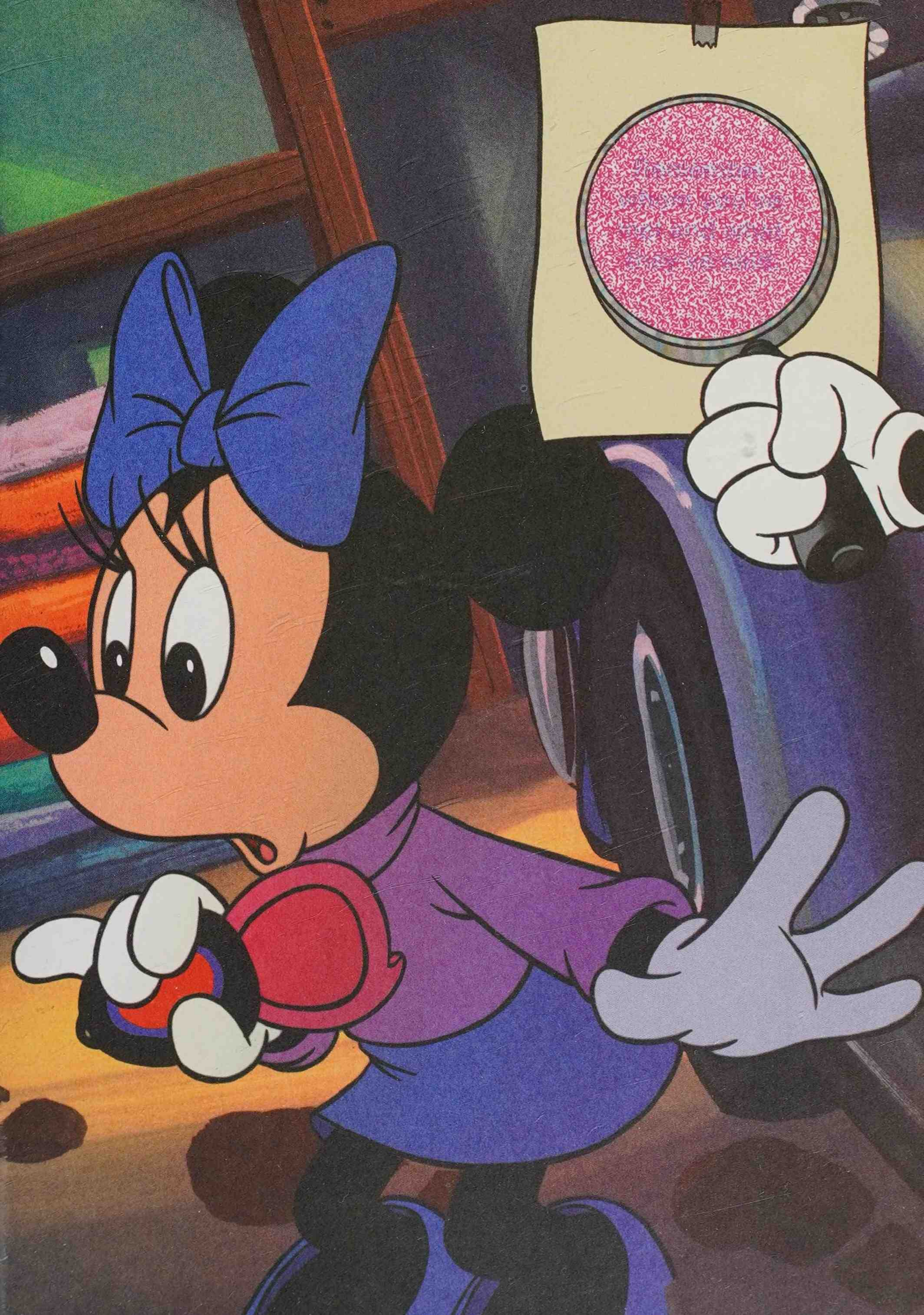








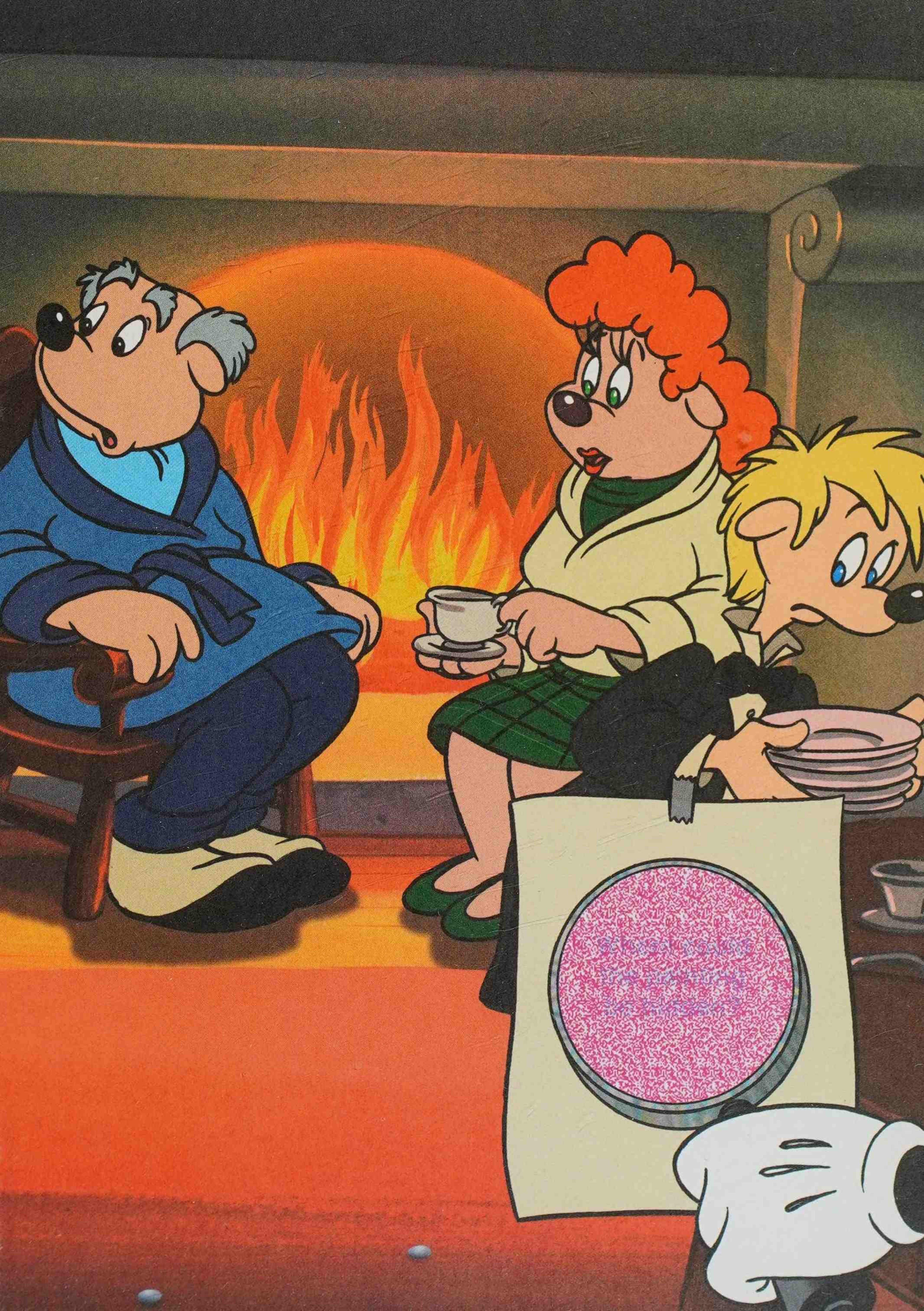
